They warmly embraced each other and exchanged good-byes, making an appointment to meet again.

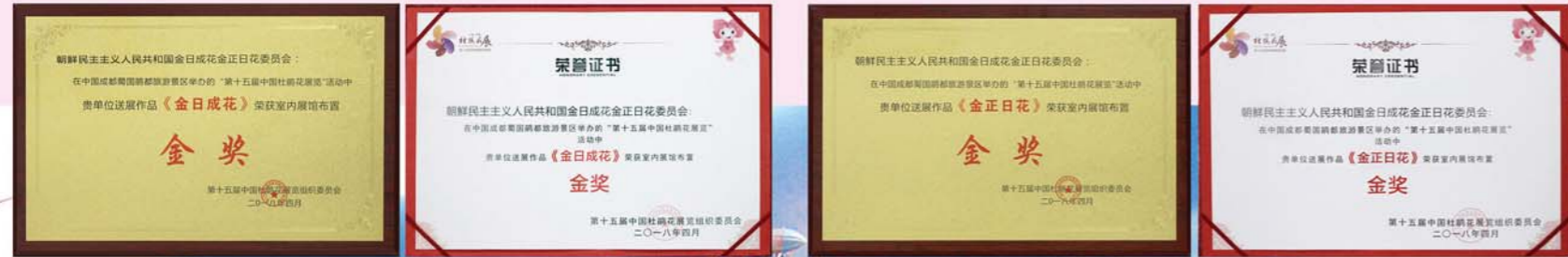

# TAEAN FRIENDSHIP GLASS FACTORY



The Taeon Friendship Glass Factory in Nampho is a building materials producer which has taken the lion's share in the production of glass needed in different economic sectors.

Inaugurated in October Juche 94 (2005), the factory has developed into a comprehensive manufacturer of various kinds of glass necessary for construction, medical treatment, foodstuff, chemical industry and other sectors.

As they displayed the spirit of self-reliance and self-development and conducted the mass technical innovation drive, its officials, workers and technicians have ensured the production of a

variety of quality products such as tempered, heat-proof, laminated, picture, patterned, frosted and hollow glass, and demand for them is on the steady rise.

Employees display great enthusiasm for increased production in their struggle to implement the strategic line of the Workers' Party of Korea on concentrating all efforts on socialist economic construction.

Workers at all workshops such as those for plate glass, tempered glass, mineral dressing, raw materials, hydrogen and nitrogen and consumer goods operate machines at full capacity as they manage equipment and technology in a responsible manner.

The factory directs big efforts into the learning of science and technology on the principle that it is precisely production, while conducting a dynamic mass technical innovation drive for conceiving and introducing new technologies.

In the course of exploring latent reserves and pooling wisdom, the employees have newly established a sulphur dioxide production process at the plate glass workshop, succeeded in developing a method of producing curved laminated glass and upgraded the mineral dressing process for removing the components of iron from silica sand, the main raw material, in order to ensure the colourlessness of glass at a high level.

The factory has also resolved technical issues for improving the quality of plate glass while preventing the oxidation of tin, which is indispensable in glass production, and saving it as much as possible. In

addition, it has recently invented and introduced dozens of new technologies to put production on normal track.

The products of the factory are sent to major

construction sites and used in improving the people's living standards.

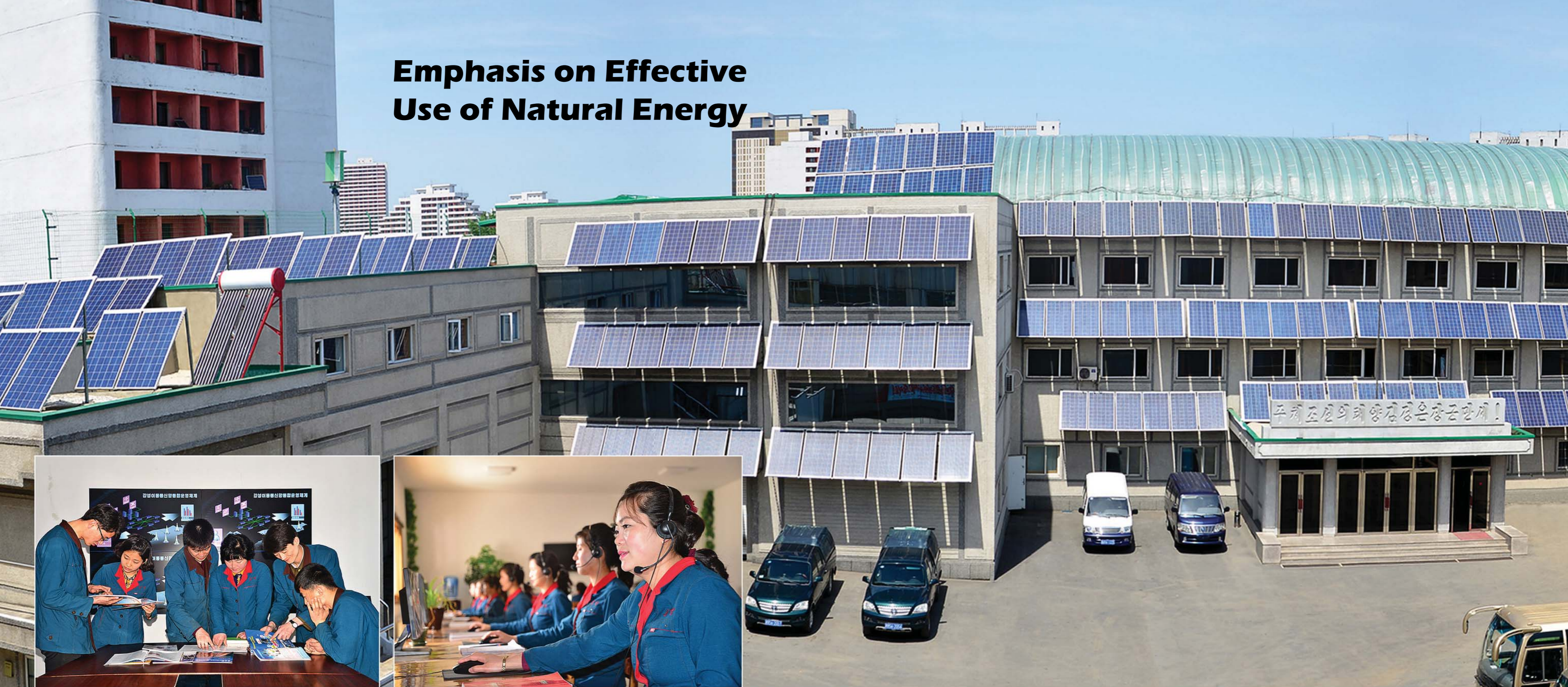

Natural energy is instrumental in business management and cultural and leisure activities

Efforts are being made briskly in the DPRK to make effective use of solar heat, wind, geotherm and other natural energy resources.

The Pyongyang mobile communications operation bureau leads others in applying renewable energy to business and leisure activities.

Each wall and roof of its E-type cosy office building is furnished with solar panels and solar water heaters to blend in well with its architectural style.

The electricity generated from them is enough to be supplied to all office rooms, service facilities, bathroom, swimming pool, mess hall, gymnasium and solar-heated greenhouse without heating system.

The solar water heaters are dedicated to heating the interior space of resting rooms in winter. The arch-style solar-heated greenhouse without heating system built on top of the office building not only produces various vegetables

but also raises a great number of fish.

The bureau which relies over 80 percent of its annual electricity demand on renewable energy aims to ensure 100 percent of electricity necessary for its management activities with renewable energy.

It is channelling big efforts into improving the capacity of generating electricity from renewable energy as it updates equipment by introducing advanced technologies such as MPPT developed by the information communication institute under the Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications and the Wonsan communication machine repair factory.

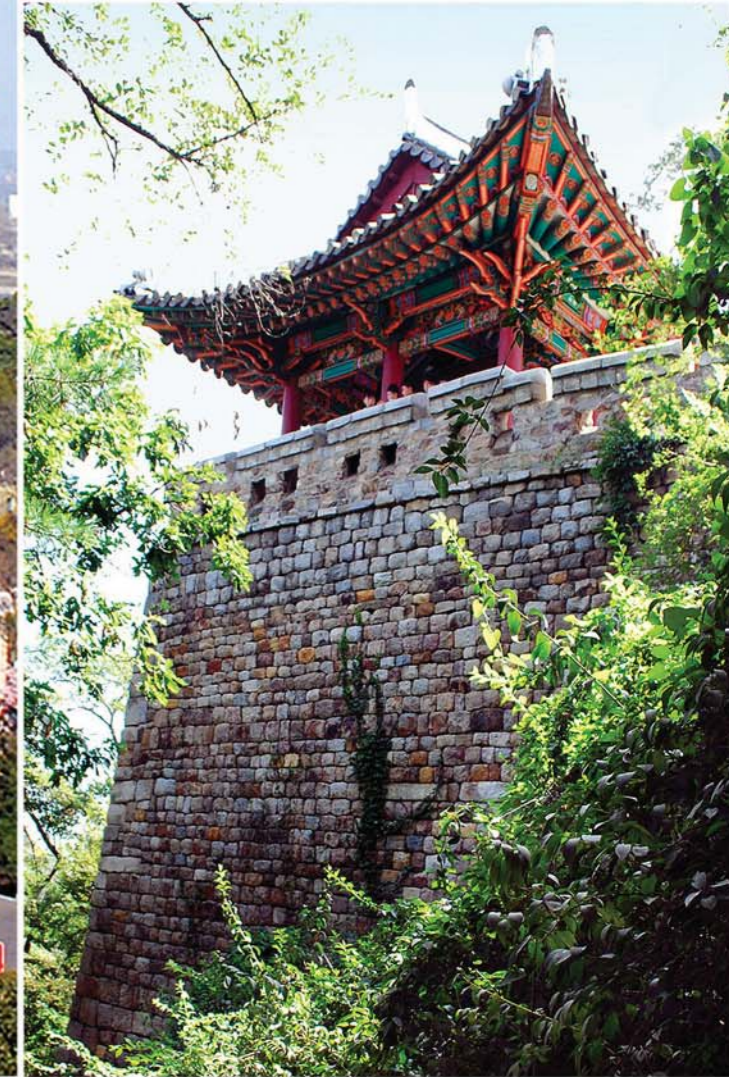
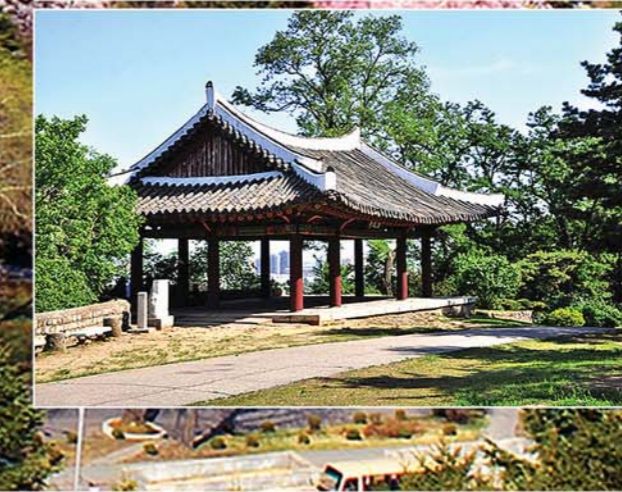

The Moranbong Theatre and

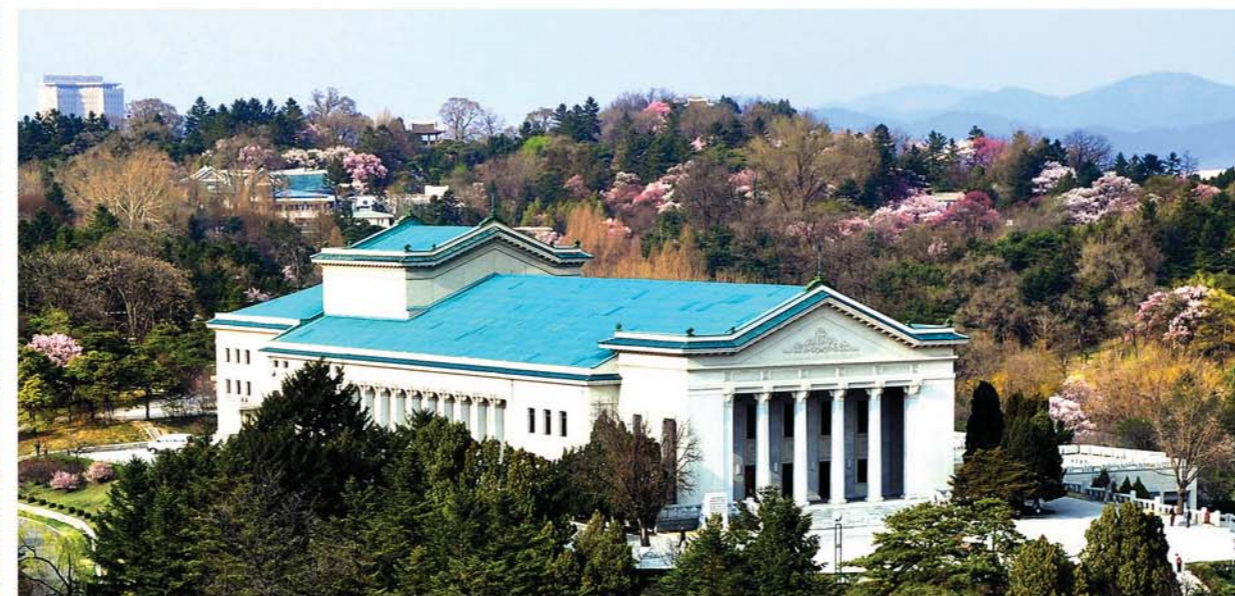

Janggu, a Korean traditional drum resembling an hourglass, generates original and elaborate rhythmic sounds to excite the audience. Students are eager to join the group to learn to play the percussion.

Every afternoon the training room is crowded with those who come from school.

To become a good janggu player, however, is far from easy.

It is especially hard to beat the toneless drum to produce solid and zestful sounds and rhythms.

It is also a challenge to learn to pose while playing to meet the characteristics of the Korean nation's own rhythms.

But the group members are undaunted yet hopeful under the tutorship of Ri Ryon Hwa, a merited teacher who has trained many good players over the past 30-odd years. She has created dozens of janggu works, namely solo *Beat the Drum to Signal the Advance* and ensemble *My Country Is the Best*.

She always customizes teaching programmes so that all the trainees could acquire rudiments in a short time.

Among the current repertoire are *We Like Our Rhythms* and *Riding the Flower Sledge of Love*, which require high-level skills such as quick cross-beating while turning round a decorative tassel.

In the past the group has produced many janggu prodigies who acquitted themselves well as they toured China, Chinese Hong Kong, Norway and Denmark as members of the Pyongyang schoolchildren's art troupe.

Still today many children enrol at the group with an ambition to become a janggu master.

## Sinuiju Traffic Safety Education Park for Children

The children's traffic safety education park newly built in Sinuiju, North Phyongan Province, is seething with children every day.

The park is a base for education and edification in traffic safety where children from kindergarteners to senior middle schoolers acquire knowledge

about traffic safety at school and extracurricular hours according to teaching programmes and learn how to drive bicycle and car.

It mainly consists of the traffic safety education hall and outdoor practice ground, covering a total area of 12 000 square metres.

Children learn traffic safety regulations for both pedestrians and drivers as well as the rudiments of driving in the education hall which consists of classrooms, places for mock drill with vehicles, e-library, simulation rooms and such spaces as corridor, hall and resting place furnished with various forms of visual aids.

At the mock drill place, schoolchildren practise driving and learn traffic regulations with the help of mock equipment.

They consolidate their knowledge about traffic safety at the outdoor practice ground which unfolds a variety of traffic conditions including miniature and mock facilities like roads of different grades, slope, bicycle path, flyover and others on streets and around roads.

As they drive cars, cross the road hand in hand and ride bicycles there, boys and girls bear in mind the traffic safety regulations.

The practice ground has some facilities of amusement games for children.

The park is now a favourite haunt of children, and their parents say it is good for both intellectual development and physical training.

As all the employees direct a lot of time and energy to making even a line, a piece of embroidery and a trinket with good feminine sense and delicacy and enriching national costume in line with the

requirements of the times, their products, especially *chima* and *jogori*, were highly appreciated at the national Korean costume show every year.

At the 15th national Korean costume show held last year the unit's *chima* and *jogori* products won the first prizes, attracting particular attention of visitors. They include women's formal dress *tangui* with an embroidery of the flower of sweet brier and fine curve, light green jacket with crimson skirt for young ladies fully representing the national form, purple jacket with embroidered apple flower and black skirt, an everyday dress for women.

It was early January when a young emergency case was brought to the South Hamgyong Provincial Children's Hospital.

He was Yun Song Min, aged 4, who had second and third-degree burns over 30 percent of his body for his moment's carelessness. He was dispatched from the county people's hospital.

A doctors' consultative meeting was held immediately to organize a treatment team and take emergency measures, which was followed by an intensive treatment.

The medical workers in charge contacted central hospitals through the telemedicine service system to consult about a correct curing way and worked day and night in keeping with ever-changing conditions of the patient. In the two-round skin grafting period, blood transfusion was given to him several times, and medicines and tonics were medicated.

All the health workers of the hospital turned out to donate their blood and skin. Students of Hamhung University of Medicine joined them.

Among those who were waiting in front of operating room to donate their blood and skin, none of them had acquainted with Song Min and his parents who work on a farm in Yonphung-ri, Kumya County.

The young patient could not recognize what a great sincerity was devoted to him. He did not know why medical workers took good care of him staying up all night and why unfamiliar elder brothers and sisters often visited the hospital and made him pleasant reading picture books and telling interesting stories.

One day in mid-April, Song Min left the hospital in good health amid the warm send-off of well-wishers.

His face was bright with pleasure that he would be able to frolic to his heart's content, but tears rolled down the cheeks of his parents who were making deep bows repeatedly holding the hand of their son. The same was the mind of the well-wishers.

The story about the recovery of Kim Tae Song was also tearful. The boy in Hoesang District, Hamhung, was taken to the hospital in early last year as a severest case, but was completely restored to health after a 120-odd-day intensive treatment.

The medical workers of the hospital, Hamhung citizens and university students who contributed to their health recovery usually say, "It is of little importance as we are all members of a family and real brothers and sisters".

Touching stories are often woven there as there are lots of people like them.

# First Olympic Medallist in Asia

She was showered with honours by the government—among them were Kim Il Sung Prize and the title of People’s Athlete.

After finishing her professional career she entered Korea University of Physical Education to qualify for a sports expert possessed of experience and theory.

Later she was appointed to such responsible posts in the sports sector as speed skating coach of the then Pyongyang Municipal Sports Club, official of the Korea Sports Guidance Committee, secretary general for speed skating

of the sports technology association, and vice-chairwoman of the sports technology federation, devoting her time and energy to the development of the country’s speed skating.

She trained many renowned speed skaters including Merited Athletes Song Hwa Son and Pak Kum Ryon.

“When we fly the national flag high in the sky over the world, the dignity and might of the motherland will be further demonstrated. To do it, we have to train harder and harder,” Han often says to coaches and players to encourage them.

In such a spirit she still serves as an official of the Ministry of Physical Culture and Sports and vice-chairwoman of the Asian skating union, despite her advanced years of over 70, contributing her mite to the development of the country’s sports.

**H**an Phil Hwa is one of the famous DPRK athletes. She made her name as a speed skater who surprised the world speed skating in the 1960s and the early 1970s.

Still vivid in the memory of the local people is the fact that she broke the record in the women’s 500m of the world speed skating championships held in Japan in February Juche 52 (1963) and then finished runner-up in the 3 000m event in the 9th Winter Olympics in February Juche 53 (1964).

It was the first medal an Asian had ever won by exploding the myth of Europeans’ dominance in the Winter Olympic Games for 40 years since 1924.

Visitors can see her name inscribed on the Olympic torch tower at the ice rink in Innsbruck, Austria, the venue of the 9th Winter Olympics.

Her tally of wins in her career also includes a bronze medal in the 3 000 metres in the world speed skating championships in Norway in February Juche 55 (1966), another bronze medal in the 1 500m and a silver medal in the 3 000m in the 10th pre-winter Olympic games in France in Juche 56 (1967), and dozens of others in international events.

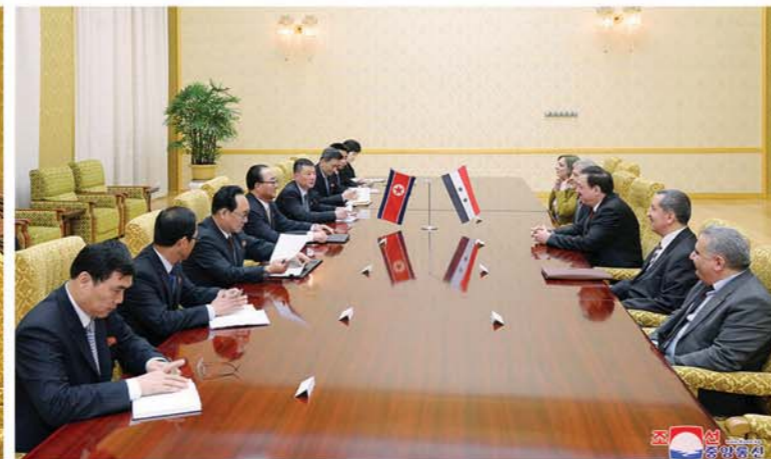
